SAFEGUARDING - TIP OF THE WEEK

Vishing is a type of phishing scam that happens on the phone. The word vishing is a combination of "voice" and "phishing". These are unsolicited phone calls from fraudsters which encourage you to give out your personal details - they pretend to be your bank, police or any other official company. These calls will often seem urgent to get you to act as quickly as possible giving you minimal time to think about whether the call is fraudulent. Sometimes you may get a "warm up" call where no information is discussed. This is to set the scene for a later call where you may be asked for information.
