


Falcon Lodge Community Centre Sunday 9 December 10.30 am - 12.00pm

TIP OF THE WEEK

PEGI Ratings - Age ratings ensure that entertainment content, such as films, DVD's and games are clearly labelled for the minimum age group for which it is suitable. The PEGI rating on a game confirms that it contains content suitable for a certain age group and above. So, a 7-rated game is suitable for everyone who is seven or older, while an 18-rated game is deemed suitable for adults only. It is not a measure of who will enjoy the game or how difficult the game is.
