We have been aware of an emerging trend, where people are playing strip Fortnite using webcams. The rule is that when you achieve "a kill" (elimination) you have to strip off, potentially adding an additional risk from children being exposed to and/or sharing indecent images whilst playing the game. Epic games suggest Fortnite is not directed at players under the age of 13 as the game contains violence and has chat features that allows video or text messaging with other online games. Its important to know the risks with these type of games. Talk to your children regularly about their online gaming and habits so you know what they are doing. Explore the games yourself to confirm you are happy with what they are doing, agree rules or time limits and manage your devices to keep safe when online.
