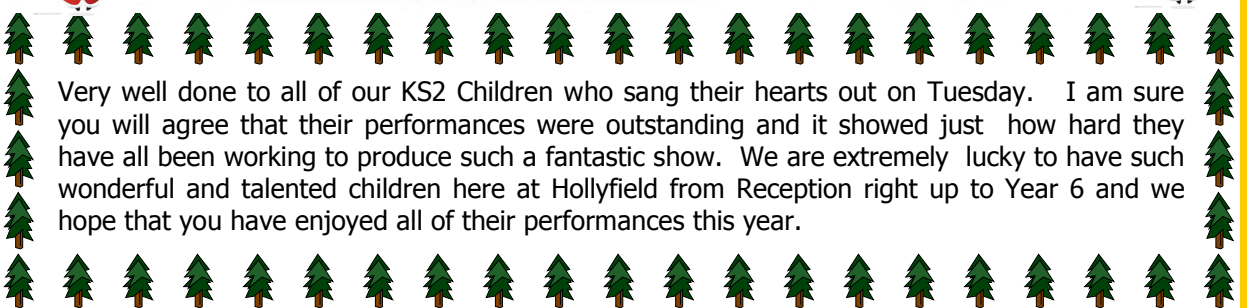




# HOLLYFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL


