- The email address is different to usual emails. It may look like its from someone you know or a company you deal with but look for anything slightly different.
- Check for Language, grammar, images or links to external websites for example. Always check that links point to legitimate sources.
- Is it out of the norm? Are you being asked to do something that wouldn't normally happen? Trust your instinct if it doesn't feel right!!!
- The message isn't personalised or uses the wrong name. Phishing attacks are distributed in bulk. It's easier to use generic salutations than to personalise them.
- The message says you need to take action to stop something from happening. Scammers user unnerving actions to encourage you to act auicker.
