This week, CEOP have released "Jessie & Friends" a series of three animations that follow the adventures of Jessie, Tia and Mo as they begin to navigate the online world, watching videos, sharing pictures and playing games. The animations are designed to help 4-7 year olds knowledge, skills and confidence helping them respond safely to risks they may encounter online.
