Leave in Term Time

As you will no doubt be aware we follow the Birmingham City Council guidelines for Leave in Term Time. This means that requests for family holidays will not be authorised. Leave in Term Time will only be granted for exceptional circumstances and family holidays do not fit this criteria. Unauthorised absences can lead to the issue of a Penalty Notice and/or a large fine. Magistrates have recently fined a Hollyfield parent £847 for taking a pupil on holiday, when we had previously advised that leave would not be authorised. If it becomes apparent that we have been advised that a child is unwell, when they have actually been on holiday this can also lead to the same outcome. We have a duty to safeguard pupils and if a child is absent without a reason, we are obliged to try and make contact with parents/carers and if necessary, contact the police to carry out a Safe and Well Check.



Reception classes and years 5 and 6 have enjoyed their respective trips to Broomey Croft Farm, St John's and Pagoda and Drayton Manor Park this week. They all had a lovely time and were fortunate with the weather. All children were well behaved and a credit to the school.
