


Geography

We focus on developing essential geographical skills and encouraging children to understand how geography impacts their lives locally and globally.

Geography is taught through a carefully planned programme that revisits important knowledge and skills, ensuring clear progression in four areas: locational knowledge, place knowledge, human and physical geography, and geographical skills and fieldwork.

We ensure that pupils develop strong mapping skills, conduct independent research and appreciate the relationship between physical geography and human activities. Our aim is to prepare children to thrive in an interconnected world.
