Read Aloud Tips

Reading at home with your child

It is vitally important that you read to and with your children at home, in order to develop their vocabulary and comprehension skills. Please see these tips :



Read with expression.

Use different voices for different characters. Your child will love it!

Let your child turn the pages, if he or she can. And, over time your child will learn which end of the book is up and that text flows from left to right...

Provide variety, but be prepared for repetition!

Nurture a reader: make books an accessible part of your child's environment.

Find a comfortable spot where you won't be distracted while reading aloud.

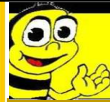
