1. Make sure the website is secure;
2. Look for a padlock by the address, ensure it is HTTPS - the "S" means the site is secure, the address bar may turn green too in some browsers to show its secure;
3. Keep software and virus protection up to date and always use strong passwords for all your online accounts;
4. Pay using a credit card not a debit card - you have more protection. Alternatively online service like pay pal mean scammers will not be able to get hold of your bank details;
5. Stay smart - if a deal looks too good to be true, it probably is.
