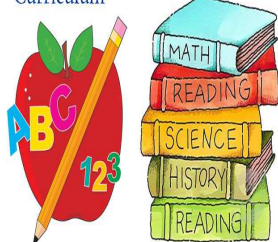
IMPORTANT
