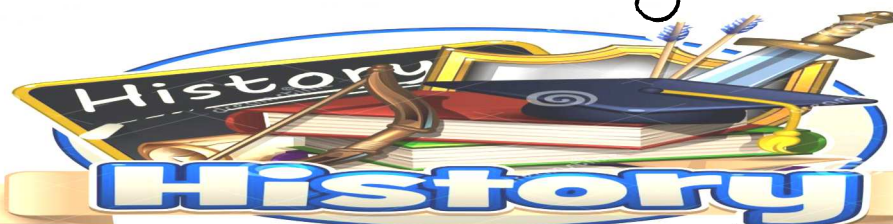




HOLLYFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL

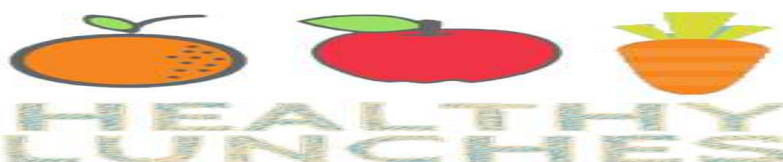

Year 3 have gone back in time starting us off through looking at the Stone-Age. Finally, Year 2 are focusing on the Great Fire of London and the events which led up to the fire and Year 1 are looking at significant explorers from the past.

Geography

In Geography our children have been identifying the four countries of the UK and their capital cities. They have also identified landmarks using aerial photographs and have used compasses and directional language to explain where the landmarks are.
