## Tip of the Week

It's almost impossible to shield children from news about traumatic events online, but you can show them the control they have in managing what they see and how they react. Older children may be particularly skilled in finding information quickly. Talk to them about how graphic content can spread quickly and help them understand how viral content works. It is important to discuss "any stories" a young person may have seen online, without directly naming viral content that may be upsetting. It is important to be sensitive when online and understand not to share graphic or distressing content for others to see.

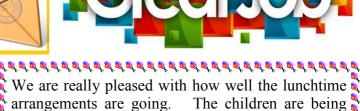
