YouTube is massively popular with children and young people - to the extent that it's replaced live broadcast TV entirely for many of them. But unlike regular TV, YouTube also offers young people the chance to be content creators as well as consumers. If your child uses YouTube and wants to create their own channel, you should be aware that YouTube doesn't allow children under 13 to create their own channel and so as a parent you should take ownership and manage the content for them. 13-17 years olds can do so but only with parental permission. website can offer some help and support if you are using YouTube or considering setting up your own channels.
