Recent reports and advice suggest that investment scams are becoming increasingly common, partly due to Covid-19 and current low interest rates. Unfortunately, investment opportunities that promise high returns from very little risk is likely to be a scam. If you chose to Invest your money, you could be investing in something that doesn't exist and lose all your money. Invites may come from cold calls, emails, texts or through the post. Be especially caution if the contact is uninvited and something you didn't expect.
