Disinformation and Misinformation

It is common to see misleading information on the internet and particularly on social media. It's important to be aware that what you see may not always be what it seems. Disinformation is where people intentionally create false or misleading information. Misinformation is where people share disinformation not realising its false or misleading.

Some tips for verifying information:

- Check the quality – Low quality images may mean it is old.
- Check the source – Is it a trustworthy source? Reverse image search photographs or video frames – Reverse Image search allows you to search the web by uploading a photo. Results may include objects within the image, similar images or website with the same or similar images.
