'Life Hacks' 'DIY Hacks' or '5 Minute Craft Hacks' amongst many others, are short videos that are becoming increasingly popular on social media. They can receive thousands of likes and shares and are often monetised, meaning the more clicks they receive the more the producers get paid through linked ads. While some of these videos are harmless and may appear to be fun, some can pose risks and cause serious harm. It's important to speak to children about the risks some of these so called hacks may pose. Always ask yourself or your child:

What is the purpose of the video?

Could the actions cause harm to yourself or others?
Does it involve the use of dangerous objects? Sharp objects, tools, chemicals etc.

If you think the video is dangerous or can cause serious harm. You can report it.
