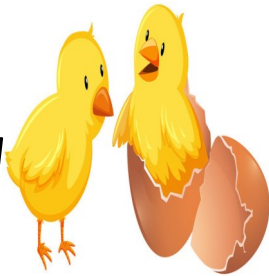




# HOLLYFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL
