### SCHOOL Attendance

As you will be aware we follow the Birmingham City Council Guidance on authorising Leave in Term Time.

Please do not take your child away on holiday without informing school. This can result in unnecessary home visits, telephone calls and even involve the Police if we have not seen a child for a prolonged period and are unable to contact parents/carers.
