2. Always remember your body belongs to you
3. No means no
4. Talk about secrets that upset you
5. Speak up, someone can help

Safeguarding

With the cost of living on the rise, criminals are using it as a tool to trick people with scams.

- Part Time jobs with quick cash returns may not be real and could be a scam - Always be cautious!
- Get in touch with someone you know for advice if you are unsure or if something looks like it might be too good to be true.
- Never read out or share one time passcodes sent to you by your bank or credit card company
- Never read out or share PIN codes generated by card readers to approve transactions. Only input them online if you know the transaction has been initiated by you. No one should ask you for these codes!
- If you receive a call from your bank/credit card company, you can always say no, hang up and call them back on a number you know to be genuine.
