Safeguarding

Holidays are the ideal time for children to spend more time online. Here are some tips that might be worth considering during the half term break.

1. Set boundaries as you would in the real world, what is appropriate content and what is not.
2. Have specified downtimes where everyone comes together to do something offline and away from devices.
3. Have a family gaming session, this can be used to understand what children are into online and the apps they are using.
4. Talk about likes and shares - Discuss the dangers and risks of sharing content particularly personal data or photos and videos. Get to know privacy settings in the apps being used and how they can help and ensure children know how to report or block content that makes them feel uncomfortable.
