Art Projects



Reception have enjoyed weaving baskets and weaving leaves with paint as part of exploring Autumn. They have also painted some fantastic fishbowls which are displayed near the Reception entrance.

Year 1 are looking forward to colour mixing and printing using a range of objects. They will be exploring the work of Louis Wain and even be acting out some his work! Look out on Twitter for the photos!

Year 2 are working on a project. They are creating a silhouette cityscape of London in the 17th Century during the Great Fire of London.

Year 3 are currently looking at prehistoric art. Children have sketched and scaled drawings influenced by Cave Art. They have created their own pigments from natural materials and thoroughly enjoyed using grains and lentils to create a background to mimic the texture of a real cave. They will use this background to paint Cave Art inspired animals.



Year 4 have been exploring reflection and symmetry by flipping and tracing patterns to create a symmetrical design. Using compasses, they have created overlapping circles which has produced some wonderful 'flower of life' designs.

Year 5 have been exploring the topic of architecture. They've carried out observational drawings of houses, printed a cross section of their drawings, sketched some fabulous architectural plans using a variety of views and designed a monument based on something they wished to commemorate. We definitely have some budding Hollyfield architects.

Year 6 have explored the work of Monet. They mixed paints to create a colour palette which they used to paint a cross section of Monet's 'Japanese Footbridge'. Year 6 have also sketched out zentangle patterns, tapping into some mindfulness! They then etched them on a polystyrene tile and used paint to create zentangle prints. We're looking forward to seeing the prints collated for a spectacular final piece!
