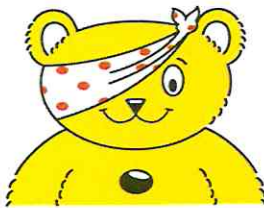

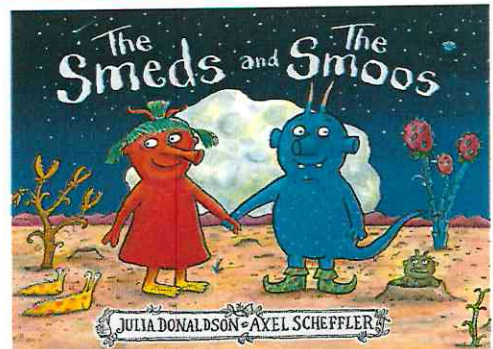
KINDNESS AWARDS
